

NOTICE REGARDING PACEMAKERS AND OTHER IMPLANTED DEVICES

Areas of the nuclear power plants owned and operated by Exelon Generation Company, LLC, have known and unknown electromagnetic fields ("EMF") that may cause pacemakers, defibrillators, or other implanted electronic devices to malfunction.

Accordingly, if you have a pacemaker, defibrillator, or other implanted electronic device, your access to work as a contractor, vendor, consultant, or employee in areas with known or unknown EMFs (specifically, the power block within the protected area or switchyard) in any nuclear power plant owned and operated by Exelon Generation will be restricted unless you do one of the following:

1. Provide documentation from your treating doctor to Exelon Generation's Site Nurse that confirms your doctor's review of this Notice, specifies the type of pacemaker or other implanted device, and specifically releases you to work in areas with known or unknown EMFs.

OR

2. Obtain a site survey or mapping of all EMFs in the nuclear power plant, provide that mapping to your treating provider, and provide documentation from your treating provider that indicates the areas of the power block or switchyard that you can and cannot access. Please be aware that EMFs change, especially during an outage. Accordingly, it is not realistic to timely conduct the appropriate survey or mapping and medical review during an outage.

Areas of the fossil generating stations owned and operated by Exelon Generation Company, LLC, have known and unknown electromagnetic fields (“EMF”) that may cause pacemakers, defibrillators, or other implanted electronic devices to malfunction.

Accordingly, if you have a pacemaker, defibrillator, or other implanted electronic device, your access to work as a contractor, vendor, consultant, or employee in areas with known or unknown EMFs of any fossil generating station owned and operated by Exelon Generation will be restricted unless you do one of the following:

3. Provide documentation from your treating doctor to Exelon Generation’s Site Nurse that confirms your doctor’s review of this Notice, specifies the type of pacemaker or other implanted device, and specifically releases you to work in areas with known or unknown EMFs.

OR

4. Obtain a site survey or mapping of all EMFs in the fossil generating station, provide that mapping to your treating provider, and provide documentation from your treating provider that indicates the areas of the fossil generating station that you can and cannot access. Please be aware that EMFs change, especially during an outage. Accordingly, it is not realistic to timely conduct the appropriate site survey or mapping and medical review during an outage.
